ROMANIA

The Romanian Consulate in Trieste was opened by Niccolò Sevastopulo at the end of the 19th century. During the period between the First and the Second World War ***the Consul Antonio di Demetrio did a lot to boost trade relations.*** In 1945 the Consulate was closed by the Allied Military Government and reopened in Asolo (province of Treviso) in 1997. Mario Moretti Polegato is now in charge as Honorary Consul.

The Consulate jurisdiction covers the following regions: Veneto, Friuli - Venezia Giulia and Trentino - Alto Adige. Its offices are open Mon - Fri, from 9am - 12.30pm . It does not process any type of visas.
